**The BAD is open to all but only judges who have undertaken the following KC education seminars are eligible to take the Multiple-Choice Exam (MCE)**

\*\*To have passed the Rules and Regulations of a Dog Show Judge

\*\* To have passed the Points of a Dog Assessment

\*\* To have attended a Conformation and Movement Seminar.

**Candidates who have met the required JEP Level 1 criteria they are eligible to sit the MCE. This criteria is as follows:**

\*\* Minimum of five years proven interest in pedigree dogs

\*\* Attend a requirements of a dog show judge seminar (but not mandatory to take and pass examination)

\*\* Attend a conformation and movement seminar

\*\* Complete a minimum of two full-day stewarding appointments
